

Eric Schmidt steps down as Chairman of Google board

Eric Schmidt has resigned from his post of chairman of the board of Goggle's parent company, Alphabet.

According to Alphabet, Schmidt does not intend to seek re-election to the board when his term expires in June 2019, but will continue to advise on technical matters.

Schmidt had joined the company in March 2001 and had served on the board for over 18 years. He served as the chief executive officer of Google from the mid 2001 until March 2011.
